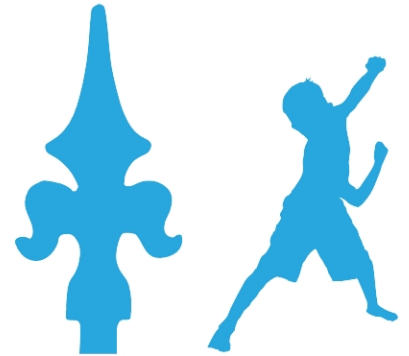
Here are some shapes that I have saved into a personal art kit. I have noted where you can access directions to create them for yourself.



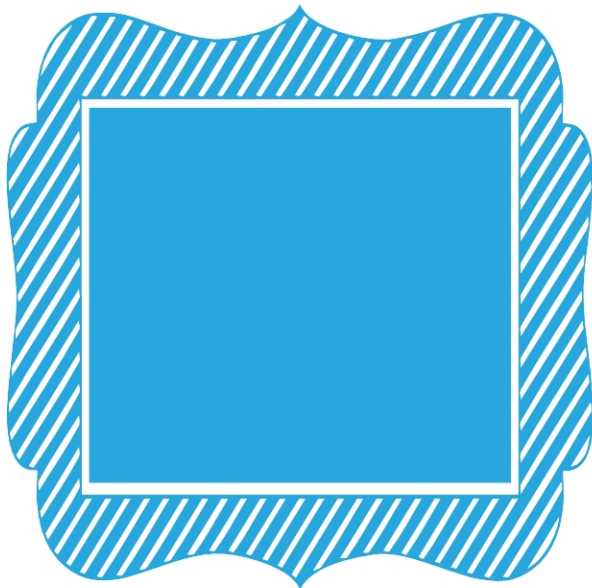

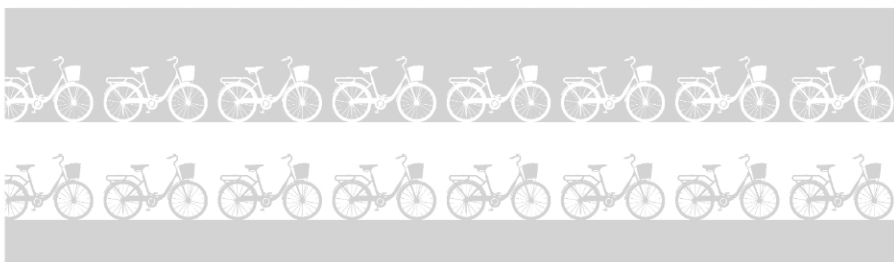
## Steps to Saving Shapes

- 1 Right Click on shape> Shape> Save as
- 2 From pop up window, select art kit, enter name for shape & click save.



Now it's time for you to give it a try.

- Find an embellishment or two and use the outliner to create an outliner shape.
- Save it to a personal art kit
- Use it on a page to cut a border, apply to the shape of a text box or any other way you can use shapes.
